<sup>1</sup> Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten: Students registered in the Prek-4 are eligible for VPK voucher. A child must be 4 years of age before September 1, and reside in Florida to participate in the VPK program.

<sup>2</sup> VPK voucher covers only for 3 hours of instruction each day. You may apply for the VPK program at <http://www.vpkflorida.org>. The VPK program is FREE for eligible children, regardless of family income.

## **Payment Policy**

- Registration fees, activity fees, and text book fees are payable at time of registration. All payments can be made in cash or checks. ***Textbooks are property of the school, consumables are returned to the students at the end of the school year.***
- All families are expected to make tuition payments according to one of the following payment plans.
  - Full Payment—The entire amount of tuition is paid directly to the school on or before September 1st by cash or check.
  - Monthly Payment—The entire amount of tuition is paid monthly over a ten month period beginning September 1st through the FACTS Management Services. Through this plan, the family authorizes the bank to transfer the tuition payment from a checking or savings account or through credit card<sup>1</sup> on the 1st of each month. An annual service fee of \$41 will be charged by FACTS to cover the administrative costs.
- Tuition fees are for ten (10) months from September to June and are to be made by the first of each month.
- Payments not received by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month will be deemed delinquent and will incur a late fee of \$25.00 and invoiced separately by FACTS.
- The student will not be allowed to attend classes after the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month until the tuition is paid in full. Absence during this period will be considered unexcused.
- Students who withdraw after the first 30 days of school will not be entitled to any refund.
- When your child is away from school, for any reason, you will still be responsible for that period of absence and are required to pay your tuition in full.
- All previously unpaid tuition must be paid by September 1st if a student is to be re-admitted the first day of class for a new school year. Payments are made directly to the school. Report cards or transfer of records will be made available only to families that have completed their financial obligations, (i.e. registration, tuition, book, late fees, etc).
- GSA is a non-profit organization. We do not receive any funding from outside sources. Thus, it is essential that all payments be made in full on the date which they are due in order for us to meet our financial obligations.
